- During 2000-01, Punjab ranked 1st among major states as per the actual growth rate of GSDP.
- During 10<sup>th</sup> Plan period, Punjab will come down to 4<sup>th</sup> position as per growth of GSDP (3 years actual and two years expected). Gujarat, Maharashtra and Haryana will take over Punjab at the end of 10<sup>th</sup> Plan.
- At the end of 11<sup>th</sup> Plan, period in 2011-12 as per projected growth rates of major states fixed by Planning Commission, Punjab is expected to slide down to 7<sup>th</sup> rank. Three more states namely Karnataka, Kerala, Tamilnadu are also expected to take over Punjab.
- Target of all 6 States except Tamilnadu which are expected to take over Punjab during the 11<sup>th</sup> Plan are above All India target.
