An Overview of Municipal Statistics Punjab

'Municipal Statistics Punjab' is prepared by Demography Section of this Organisation. Important data of all the Municipal Councils/Corporations of the State is collected and compiled in this book.

Scope

In this report the statistics relating to Municipal Councils/ Corporations for the year 2003-04 was given. There were 129 municipal councils, 4 municipal corporations in the Punjab State. Municipal Councils-wise data is given in each table of this publication.

Process

Information related to this report is collected by the Deputy Economic & Statistical Adviser at district headquarters, as per performae of Central Statistical, Organisation Govt. of India, New Delhi, from the Municipal Councils which falls in the district and drafting of above report is done by Demography Section at the head office, Chandigarh. Data related to the Municipal Councils is divided in twelve Chapters like Area & Population, Health & Vital Statistics, Education and Culture Statistics, Public Utilities, Housing & Construction, District-wise Income and Expenditure of Municipal Councils, Slaughter House Statistics, Bank offices, Veterinary Facilities and Sports Facilities, Petrol & Diesel Pumps & Gas Agencies.

Population

Ranking on the basis of population the Municipal Corporation Ludhiana (1398467) is at first number, Amritsar Municipal Corporation (1003917) is at second number, Jalandhar (712631) is at third number and Patiala Municipal Corporation (323884) is at fourth number.

Health & Vital Statistics

Municipality wise information of number of live births registered of Municipal Corporations Ludhiana, Amritsar, Jalandhar and Patiala is 5815, 9175, 18239, 10266 and the number of registered deaths is 10263, 9332, 6206, 3742 and the number of infant deaths is 262, 201, 150, 196 respectively.

In the above given Municipal Corporations during the year 2003-04 deaths due to accidents were 174, 275, 48, 133 respectively.

On the basis of availability of medical facilities during the period under reference the number of govt. hospitals, dispensaries and doctors in Ludhiana

(Municipal Corporation) was 8, 25 and 113, Amritsar (Municipal Corporation) was 1, 14 and 33, Jalandhar (Municipal Corporation) was 6,24 and 101 and Patiala (Municipal Corporation) was 7, 22 and 502 respectively.

Education

Education plays a strategic role in economic development of a country. Establishment of educational institutions in the nearby places is further more important. From this point of view the number of primary, high & higher secondary schools in four major Municipal Corporations was as Ludhiana (110,120), Amritsar (134, 81), Jalandhar (92, 93) and Patiala (56, 32) respectively.

During the year 2003-04 Income and Expenditure of four Municipal Corporations is given below:-
