**Subject: Release of funds of Rs. 100.00 crore for repair/restoration of damaged water courses under district level Punjab Nirman Programme during 2006-07.**

Please refer to the subject cited above.

2. This is in continuation of this department's sanction issued vide memo No. (LPD/Allocation)2006/17604 Dated 28th Nov.,2006 vide which an amount of Rs. 100.00 crore (Rs. hundred crore) was distributed to the 8 districts in the State for repair/restoration of damaged water courses. Vide this sanction an amount of Rs. 27.50 crore, Rs.15.50 crore and 10.00 crores were distributed to districts Bhatinda, Mansa and Faridkot respectively. Now it has been decided by the Hon'ble CM, Punjab that a sum of Rs. 10.60 crore may be placed at the disposal of Punjab State Electricity Board for providing single bulb connection under the new State Plan Scheme 'Rajiv Gandhi Gramin Vidutikaran Yojana' (RGGVY) to under privileged sections of society as per detail given below:-

3. The amount of Rs. 10.60 crores as indicated in the above table is placed at the disposal of Punjab State Electricity Board for providing electric connections under RGGVY. The list of beneficiaries etc. be approved by the concerned DP&DBs. The remaining funds amounting Rs. 42.40 crores for repair/restoration of damaged water courses will be utilized as per guidelines issued by Planning Department vide its Memo No.LPD-Allocation/17338 dated 22/11/06 and No. 17604 dated 28/11/06.

4. It will be the responsibility of the concerned departments/Executing agencies to ensure that funds are drawn from the Government Treasury as per the actual requirement.

5 The cost estimates should be got approved from the competent Authority wherever necessary before releasing the funds to the concerned Departments/Executing Agencies.

6. No funds will be provided to private agencies.
