- Corresponding figure during 2000-01 are 36.63%, 23.13% and 40.24% respectively.

- Corresponding figure during 2005-06 are 31.16%, 25.75% and 43.09% respectively.
- Corresponding figure during 2009-10 are 24.92%, 31.55% and 43.53% respectively.
