

**Subject: Needs of Border Areas of Punjab-Information sought by Planning Commission in pursuance of discussions held on 20/11/2006.**

There are 4 border blocks. The brief details are:

The details of 18 border blocks are annexed herewith.

2. The information sought on the 4 points is as under:

(1) **Rural toilets in 18 Border Blocks-** The State government provides an assistance of Rs. 6300/- per unit for construction of rural toilets in the villages. So far we have released a sum of Rs. 180 crore in the entire State. However this amount is too meager to complete the construction of the required number of toilets. A sum of Rs. 34.40 crore is required for completing the required number of toilets in the 18 border blocks. The total number of toilets required is 54,598. The Districtwise break-up is as under:

(2) **Link roads in 4 border districts-** All the villages are connected with the block headquarters and there is no requirement of construction of any new link road in the border districts under PMGSY. However link roads of 521.27 Kms needs to be

strengthened, widened and upgraded in the four border districts at an estimated cost of Rs. 233.10 crore which qualify for upgradation under PMGSY. The district-wise break-up is as follows:

**(3) Primary /Elementary Schools in Border Districts-** As per the State government policy there should be a Primary school within one kilometer and Elementary School within 3 Kms distance. There is no requirement of any primary school in the four border districts. However 100 Primary Schools are required to be upgraded to Elementary Schools at an estimated cost of Rs. 16.36 crore.

In addition there is requirement of Rs. 22.40 crore for providing of additional class rooms, development of library and library books and development of play grounds in the existing schools in the border districts. The total requirement is therefore for Rs. 39 crore.

**(4) Health Centres-** As per Government of India norms, there should be a Primary Health Centre for every 30,000 people in rural areas. There is

requirement of 26 new PHCs as are detailed below in the four districts:-

The State government has recently transferred Subsidiary Health Centres (Village dispensaries) to the Zila Parishads and these have been handed over to Service Providers (MBBS Graduates) on contract basis. These dispensaries are in a dilapidated condition since these were not functioning for want of staff. A sum of Rs. 1.50 lacs per dispensary is required for renovation and rehabilitation. The detailed requirement of funds is as follows:
